Around 60 Students and 10 Faculty members were present.

This was the day when Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was crowned in 1674. The event proved to be the watershed moment in Maratha history as it also marked the beginning of Hindavi Swarajya in India. It is also significant to know that on this day, Shivaji was given the title of 'Shakakarta' which means 'founder of an era' in English and 'Chhatrapati' (paramount sovereign). He also took the title of Haindava Dharmodhhaarak (protector of the Hindu faith) during his coronation ceremony in Raigad. Over the course of his life, Shivaji made history with some of the most significant battles of the Maratha empire. He is mostly known for expanding the Maratha empire and establishing a progressive civil rule with well-structured administrative organisations. He is also revered as the hero of Hindus as he revived ancient Hindu political traditions and court conventions during his rule as King.

Prof. Gayatri Bhoyar addressed the students regarding importance of Shiv watcher addressed Diwas to the gathering. The event received an overwhelming response from all. Ruchika Chatap, Vaidehi Meshram, Akash Shahastrabudhe and Simran Twari coordinated the event,

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




