



Student of CSE and **Creative Co-head** of Schologamma forum Ms. Athira Nair perform a wonderful singing performance at the installation ceremony.



Brief Description of Project:

Rotary India organized DEFEAT DIABETES CAMPAIGN in collaboration with Research Society for Study of Diabetes in India (RSSDI) to attempt a World record for maximum number of blood glucose testing with a target of 1 million testing in one single day. Rotary India provided us with a blood glucose testing kit. Rotaract club of JDCOEM organized a campaign for blood glucose testing on 29th of September 2021 with a target of 100 testing in a single day, we achieved the target and performed 133 testing near Division Sports Complex, Mankapur, Nagpur. Registration of the candidate was done on spot on a mobile application. Testing was done using a glucometer and the result of the tests was declared on the spot. Hon. Director Prof. S. M. Bang Sir visited our camp and guided us.

We were grateful for the presence of Prof. Nikhil Bhende Sir who stayed with us throughout the campaign.

The response was very good, a lot of people were really interested in the campaign. They took active participation by coming to us and getting their glucose checked. The whole campaign was performed by following and keeping the government COVID-19 norms in practice. Also, the team coordinated and worked very well to achieve the team goal.






