Student of CSE and **Creative Co-head** of Schologamma forum Ms. Athira Nair perform a wonderful singing performance at the installation ceremony.

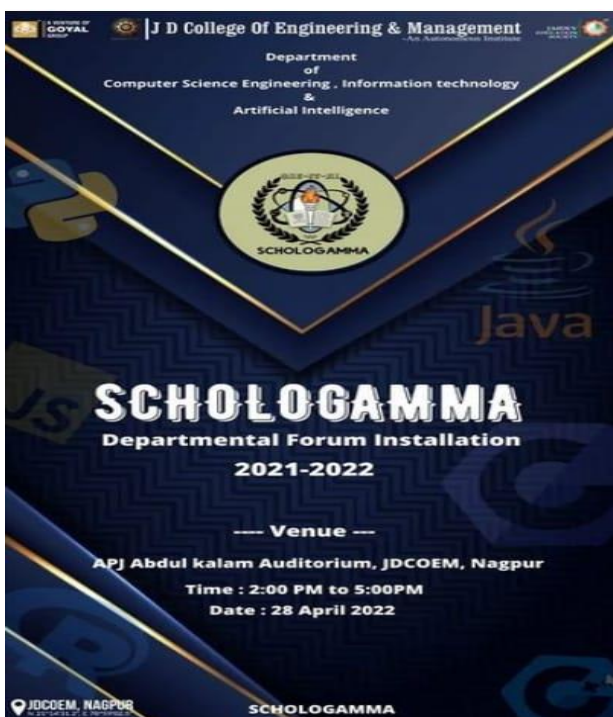
The **Vice-President** of Schologamma Ms. Pradnya Kotangale gives a vote of thanks to all the dignitaries, faculties, and student attendees of the events.

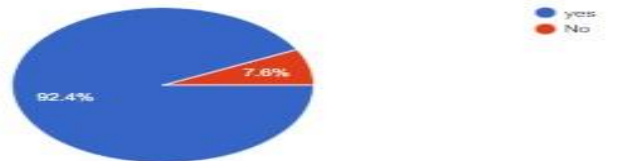

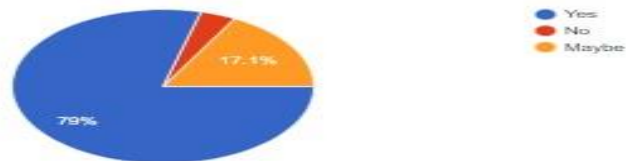

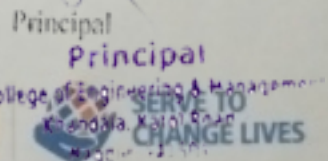
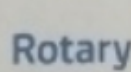
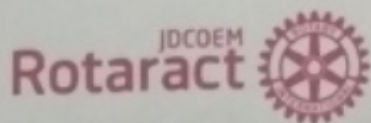
Img 2: Registration of candidate for testing Diabetes

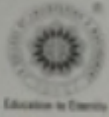


Img 3: Registration of candidates for diabetes testing

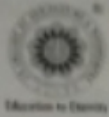


Img 3: Participant planting Tulsi plant
