SCOPE:

OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY

- 1. To provide accessible and inclusive education at the College.
- 2. To promote divyangjan friendly facilities
- 3. To ensure effective delivery of services to differently-abled Students and Staff of the college
- 4. To create Inclusive Culture to avoid discrimination, exploitation and exclusion of differently-abled Students and Staff

The focus of the policy is on the following:

- 1. To make provision for admission to persons with disabilities in the programs offered by the College as per the directions of the Competent authority.
- 2. To ensure that the design of the building creates a barrier free environment for the differently abled like ramps, friendly pathways etc.
- 3. Human assistance such as provision for enquiry and information and support in moving in and out of the campus should be provided.
- 4. To ensure that proper signages are located at the appropriate places in the campus.
- 5. To provide accessible, gender sensitive, safe, and functional washroom facilities for the differently abled.
- 6. Special facility of wheelchair is to be provided for injured or differently abled students.
- 7. Provision of buses with low floor & seats specially earmarked for the differently abled.
- 8. To provide accessible textbooks and study material to all students with disabilities.
- 9. Use of assistive technology like screen reader software
- 10. Provisions in the Exam Manual to meet the particular needs of differently abled or injured students.
- 11. To ensure the sensitization programmes for all teaching, non teaching staff and students.
