Eligibility Criteria:

- 2. Need-Based Financial Aid: Eligibility for need-based financial aid is assessed based on the student's and their family's financial situation, including income, assets, and expenses. Applicants are required to submit detailed financial documentation as part of the evaluation
- 3. Special Scholarships and Grants: Eligibility for special scholarships and grants is determined based on specific criteria related to the nature of the scholarship, such as athletic ability, artistic talent, community service, or research achievements. Applicants may be required to provide evidence or documentation supporting their eligibility.
- 4. Sibling Discount: The sibling discount is available to families with two or more siblings concurrently enrolled at JDCOEM. The discount is applied to the tuition fees of each sibling as per the college's policy.
