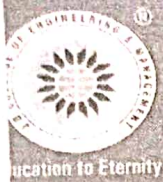

Cultural Exposure: Including culturally diverse activities and sharing experiences can broaden the children's cultural awareness and understanding.




Positive Memory Formation: Creating a joyful and memorable experience during the event contributes to positive memory formation, which can have a lasting impact on the children's outlook on life.
