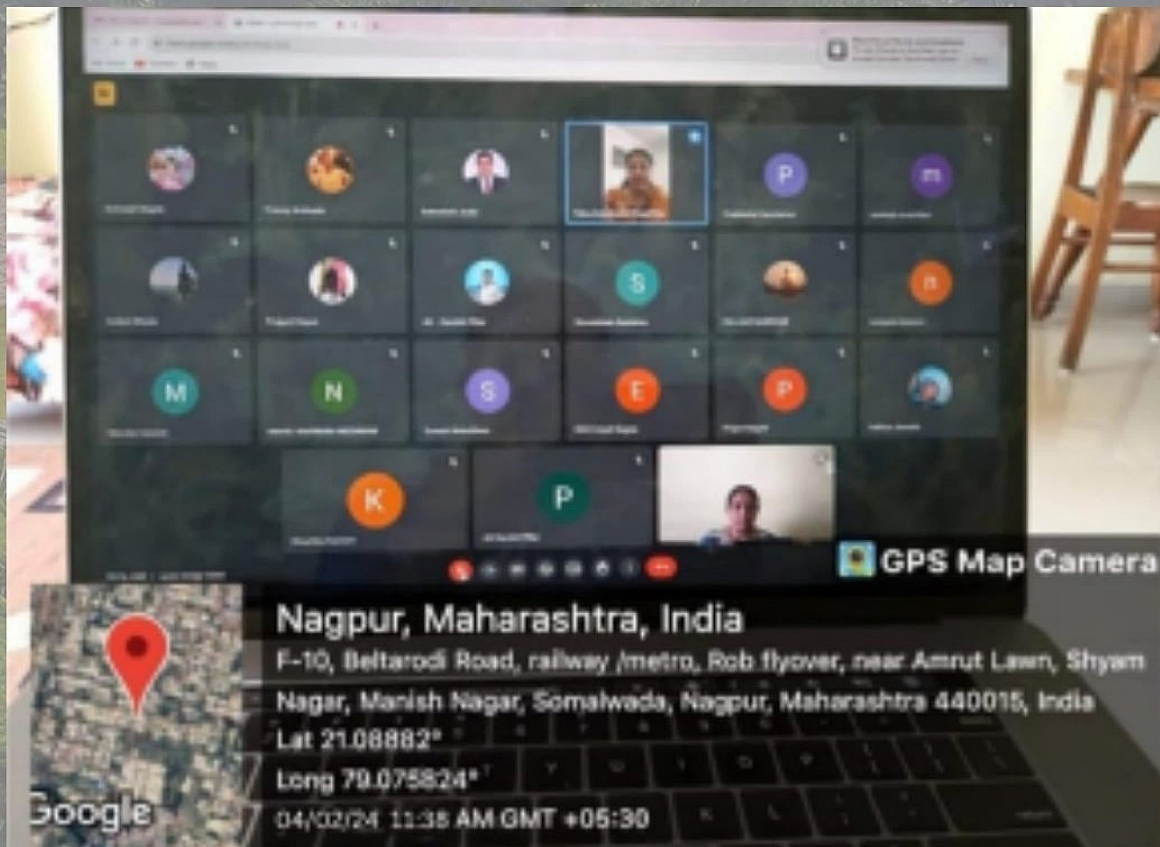


# EVENT NAME: WORLD CANCER DAY

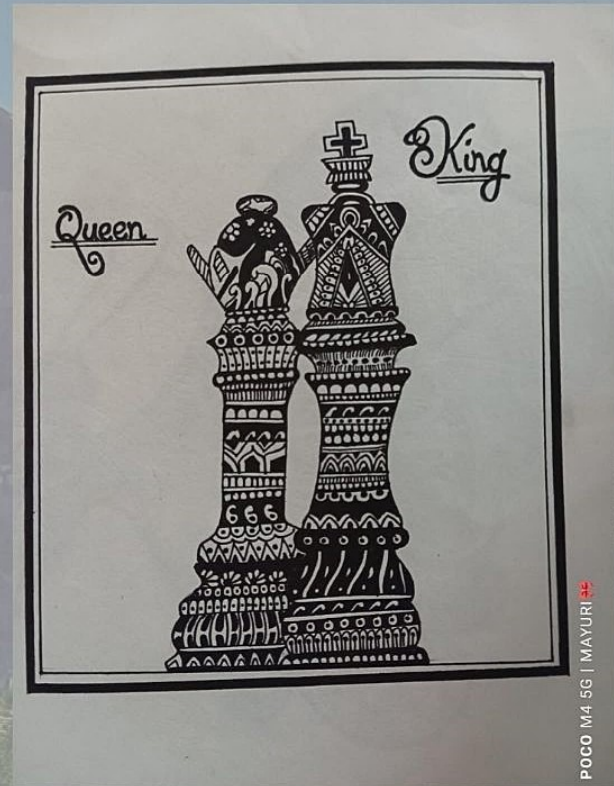
